**Criteria for youth applications:**

1. Maximum contribution available to an individual youth applicant: \$200  
Again please note that all applications must be connected to a formal team or group. Funds will not be issued to an individual applicant
2. Maximum contribution available to a team, group or multiple youth applying from the same team or group: \$1000

*Note that youth team requests are available for a maximum of 5 youth per team/group and are only applicable to a national level of play or above in a recreation or sport activity. Youth must live within the catchment area – see below.*

3. Youth must live within the catchment area that the PRRA serves; between the areas of Goodwood to West Dover.
4. The funding request must support the youth applicant's participation in a recreational activity or competition, at the national level and above, or the highest level that applies to the activity. *For example, should provincial level be the highest level of competition for that particular sport, support to the individual will be considered.*
5. Youth must make a contribution toward the cost of participating through fundraising.
6. Youth are to report back to PRRA after participation in event, either in person or by email confirming participation.
7. Youth/groups/teams are required to submit a write up about participation in event for the Prospective newsletter.
8. Youth applications are accepted year round (while youth funds last)
